

Radiologic Technology Application Worksheet For applications due on March 15, 2027.

*It is **STRONGLY** recommended that students meet with a Santa Rosa Junior College Health Sciences counselor to review and ensure the accuracy of the worksheet **PRIOR** to submitting the application.*

How to Complete the Radiologic Technology Application Worksheet - The point system worksheet is provided to aid students in planning their classes prior to applying to the Radiologic Technology program and is subject to change by the department without notification. **All courses listed will be compared to official transcripts for verification prior to points being awarded.** Ties in points will be broken on the basis of overall GPA as listed on the student's official transcripts on file with A & R on application due date. Any further ties in points will be broken by random drawing.

* = **Recency Required** – write in semester course completed (example: Fall 2022). For the applications for the incoming 2027 class, the recency prerequisite coursework shall have been completed no earlier than the spring of 2022 (5 years).

Semester Units Earned may vary - dependent on the number of course units.

Maximum Semester Units Applied to Application – Based on the number of units for listed SRJC courses. If a course is deemed equivalent and transferrable to an SRJC course (and there would be no other reason to retake a course), then the points that are listed for the SRJC course would be applied and awarded.

Grade (Point) Equivalents: A= 3 B=2 C=1. Write in both the letter grade and the point equivalent for each course. (example: A (3))

Points Award Calculations: Multiply the number of units applied by the grade point equivalent for each course. (EXAMPLE: ANAT 58 = 3 units; Grade (Points) = A(3); 3 X 3 = 9 points awarded)

Grades for course substitutions that are a 2-course series: Enter the grade of the second course in the series.

Grades for High School AP Classes: Passing scores of 5, 4 or 3 will be accepted as equivalent to the letter grade of A, B or C. Once AP course equivalents are determined to be letter grade A, B or C, the Grade (Point) Equivalents, listed above, will apply for calculating and awarding points.

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Consideration of additional points may be awarded at the time of application for each of the following:

- Documented completion of an Associate degree or higher from an institution accredited by an agency **recognized by the ARRT.** (up to 1 point)
 - a. Must be verifiable on transcripts submitted with the application.
- Certificates/Licenses in Health Care related occupations (1point)
 - a. Must provide copy of certificate or license.
 - b. Must include clinical practice (direct patient care) as part of the certification. (Did you practice this skill on an actual patient?)
 - c. (***EXAMPLES:*** XT, CNA, MA, EMT, LVN, Medic, Corpsman, Pharm Tech, Dental Assistant, Dental Hygienist, EKG tech, Phlebotomy, etc.)
 - d. Certification/license does not have to be current, but must have been completed in the past 10 years.
- Military experience. (1 point)
 - a. Must provide copy of DD214; Honorable Discharge **OR** Proof of Service letter from the Department of Veterans Affairs.
- Prior application to the Santa Rosa Junior College Radiologic Technology program (1 point).
- Verified documentation of paid work experience in a related health care field providing direct patient care **OR** completion of RADT 99. (1 point)
 - a. Direct patient care is “hands-on”, face-to-face contact with patients for the purpose of diagnosis, treatment and monitoring – minimum of 6 months part-time employment.
 - b. Must provide letter from current/former employer verifying employment.
 - i. Must be on official letterhead with an original signature and must include applicant’s name, start/end date, number of hours worked per week, job title, job duties specifying type of direct interaction with patients.
 - ii. If letterhead is not available, attach business card of person writing the letter or email.
 - iii. Email should be sent from the company email address, not sender’s personal account.
